

Minutes
Pleasanton Public School Board
Special Meeting
July 22, 2020

Meeting notice posted at the Pleasanton Post Office, River Stop, and Town & Country Bank.

The agenda was available at the office of the Superintendent.

The Board of Education for Pleasanton Public Schools, District 10-0105, met in special session at 3:30 pm at the school. Members present were Pawloski, Hand, Nichols, Kingston, Klein and Loeffelholz.

President Pawloski called the meeting to order and opened with a statement that the board follows the Open Meetings Act, a copy of the law is located in the room, followed by the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Nichols, seconded by Klein to adopt the agenda. Hand (yes), Kingston (yes), Klein (yes), Loeffelholz (yes), Nichols (yes), Pawloski (yes). Motion carried 6 - 0.

Chris Boucher requested to address the board. He brought up concerns over the decision to begin the school year with face masks optional. Mr. Pawloski thanked him for sharing his input and concerns.

Via Zoom, NASB representatives Marcia Herring and Kori Stanosheck led a discussion on the results of our Strategic Plan Needs Analysis Data and Goal survey conducted earlier in the school year. Mr. Pawloski led a discussion on the hiring of a new superintendent beginning in the 2021-2022 school year and the various options available in regard to search firms.

There was a general discussion of the results of the NASB survey information that was presented in regard to Board Leadership, decision making and prioritization in regard to the 2020 school year.
