May 11, 2020

Meeting posted at the Pleasanton Post Office, River Stop, and Town & Country Bank. Since this meeting was conducted on-line via Zoom the notice included the link for the public to join the meeting.

The Board of Education for Pleasanton Public Schools, District 10-0105 met virtually via zoom due to COVID-19 at 5 p.m. Members present via zoom were Pawloski, Hand, Nichols, Kingston, Klein and Loeffelholz. Linda Kohlscheen was a staff representative.
