### Fall Semester:

- Talk to counselor about all the courses you need to go to college and the specific requirements for the different colleges
- Take dual credit courses to get college credit (fall and spring semester)

- Attend college fairs. **\*\*We will have a virtual college fair in September. More info to come soon.**
- Tour colleges

### Winter:

- Prepare for ACT - [actstudent.org](http://actstudent.org)

### Spring:

- Attend college fairs
- Go on college tours
- Narrow down to top colleges
- Take the ACT test (the high school gives one, but can sign up on your own for a different one)
- Summer job, create a budget, start saving for college

### Summer:

- Retake ACT to improve score
- Update Resume - include awards, honors, volunteer work, and other activities
- Job shadow
- Start researching and applying for scholarships
